You may find daily newspapers, while the most popular weeklies and monthlies are available in the Didactic Reading Room



The librarian helps you find articles and books for final projects and thesis



It is permitted to use a camera or phone within the limits of permitted use (strictly private use, not for distribution)



The scanner in the Didactic Reading Room is available for all users



There are stands in front of the library entrances where you can park your bike

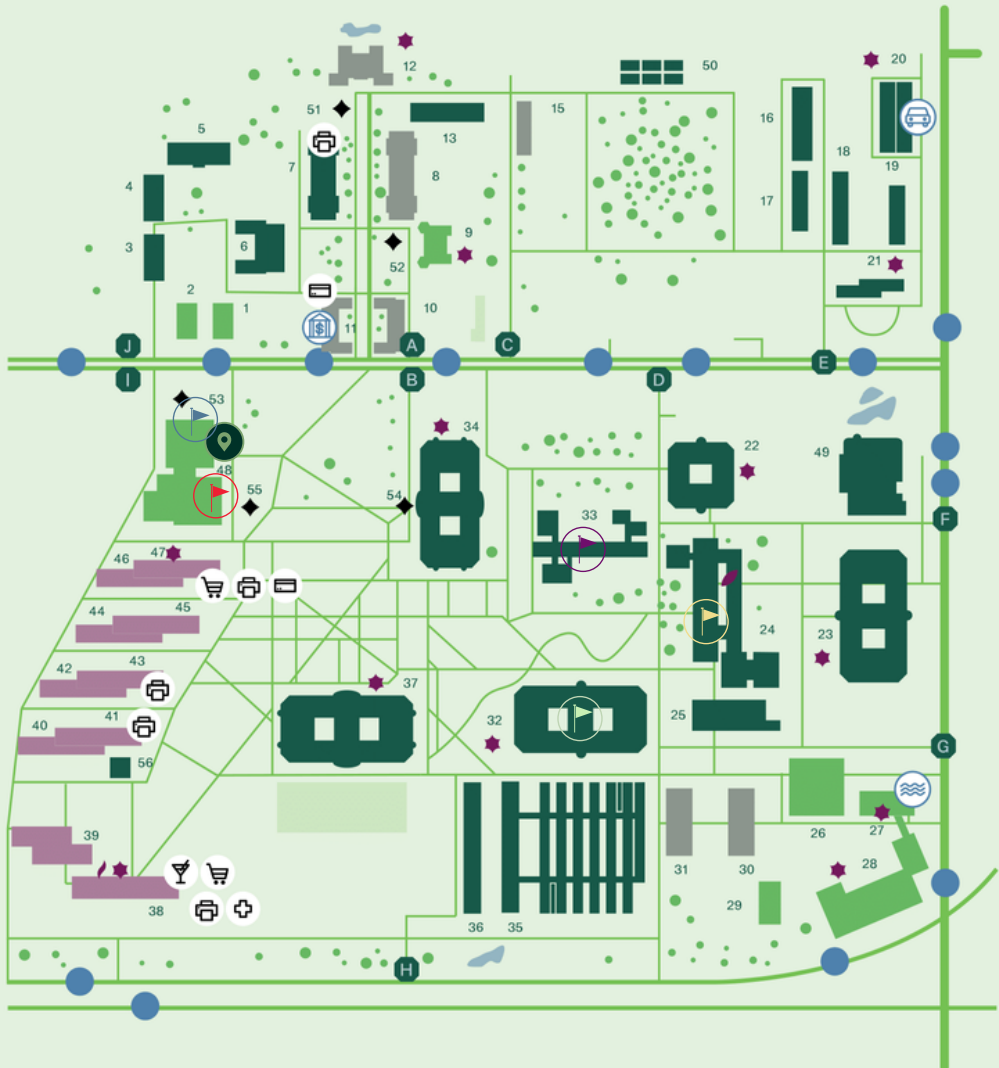

How to get to us?



by underground: M1 – Ursynów station



by bus: 166, 401, 193, 503 – SGGW - Biblioteka bus stop



by car: entry B, Nowoursynowska Street – paid underground parking lot; entry J, Nowoursynowska Street – on-ground parking, free of charge



by bicycle - stands available in front of the A (roofed) and C entrances
